In order to enable you to complete B.Com. Programme within the minimum period of three years, they are allowed to take 32 credits wortt of courses in each year. Only Group 1 and 2 courses are available in the first year. In first year you have to choose courses worth 16 credits only from elective courses. Selected 8 credits from each group. The rest of the Elective Courses would be offered in second and third year.

You should offer elective courses in such a way that overlapping is avoided i.e. you should offer courses of 8 credits from Group 1 and 8 credits from Group2.
