- 21.1. Title: Diploma in Human Resource Management (DHRM)
- 21.2. Faculty: Faculty of Management
- 21.3. Duration: One Year (Two Semesters)
- 21.4. Eligibility: 10+2 in any discipline on merit from a recognized board of secondary education.
- 21.5. Seats: The basic unit will be of 60 seats. Multiples of this unit can also be set up by the Board of Management.
