1. The Academic Council congratulated the Registrar and his team for the successful completion of the university inspection by CGPURC.
2. The Academic Council approved the new additional programmes and their fees structure for 2021-2022 and other new programmes and their fee structure for 2022-23 as per **(Annexure-I)**
3. The Academic Council approved the Academic Calendar of the University. **(Annexure-II)**
4. The Academic Council approved the new Course Structure and Syllabus of M.Sc.-IT, B.Lib.Sc., BA, B.Com., M.Com., BBA, MBA. **(Annexure-III)**

7. The Academic Council also ratified the names of teachers to be appointed as Research Supervisors for the Ph.D. programme as approved by the Research Advisory Committee. **(Annexure-V)**
8. The Academic Council decided to strictly follow the UGC Guidelines for Ph.D. and conduct an entrance test for admission to the Ph.D. programme. **(Annexure-VI)**
9. The Academic Council approved the Fee Structure for Ph.D. as proposed by Dean-Academics with minor changes. The approved Fee Structure shall be notified by the Registrar. **(Annexure-VI)**
10. The Academic Council approved starting new Diploma and Certificate programmes in Aviation, Beauty & Wellness, Beautician & Parlour Management, Sewing and Nursing & Caretaking.
11. The Academic Council approved the proposal of the Registrar to apply for AICTE approval of MBA programme at the earliest.
12. The Academic council approved the setting up of HRD Centre for faculty development and IQAC for quality improvement and also directed to begin the process of applying to NAAC for accreditation.
